

## **X. NOTICE OF PREPARATION**

A Notice of Preparation is sent to each responsible agency, federal agency involved in approving or funding the project, and to each trustee agency responsible for natural resources affected by the project. Responses are to identify significant environmental issues and reasonable alternatives and mitigation measures that the responsible agency will need to have explored in the Draft EIR, and whether the agency will be a responsible agency or trustee agency for the project. On April 13, 2009, a Notice of Preparation for the project was sent to the following agencies. Responses are required within 30 days or it is presumed the agency has no response. Copies of the response letters are included in Appendix J.
